

Cyclone Yasi Preston Clothier – Homeowner Mission Beach QLD


"Our builder recommended we install Breezway Altair[™] Louvre Windows when we were renovating this house due to their very good reputation. We weren't quite sure what to expect from Cyclone Yasi so we put some tape down the



middle of the louvres and stood up against the door with a mattress to prevent the doors from blowing in."

"Before the eye of the cyclone hit, we spent 45mins watching an old shed next door through our louvres. The shed roof landed on our patio and we were lucky we had the opportunity to remove it during the eye so that no damage would be caused by it flying around in the wind after the eye had past. I don't think the cyclone was as bad as Cyclone Larry (which was more concentrated and shorter) but Yasi has certainly damaged our vegetation and is really going to affect us for months (perhaps even years)."

"We installed 102mm aluminium blades (with flyscreens) because they are so easy to keep clean but chose the glass for the view out the back onto the beach. We are very happy with how well the Altair[™] Louvres held up considering we live right across from the beach. They sealed and performed better than our front door and bifold windows in the kitchen (which leaked terribly). I would highly recommend Altair[™] Louvre Windows to anyone simply because it is a logical product to install to control cross ventilation into the home. Another advantage we found is that we hardly have to use our air conditioning because of the cool breezes that flow throughout the house which is great for our electricity bill."
